“DEEPPFAKE CEO” SCAM: VOICE CLONING IS THE NEXT CYBER THREAT

The phone rings. It’s your boss – same voice, tone, and urgency. They need a quick favor: an immediate wire transfer or sensitive client information to close a deal. It feels routine, trusted, and time-critical. So you act. *But what if it isn’t really your boss?*

AI voice cloning has turned this once-far-fetched scenario into a real and growing threat. Cybercriminals can now perfectly mimic a person’s voice using only seconds of audio pulled from interviews, presentations, or social media. In moments, a normal call can become a costly mistake – money lost, data compromised, and damage that extends well beyond the office.

These scams represent a dangerous evolution of Business Email Compromise (BEC). While organizations have learned to spot suspicious emails, we haven’t trained ourselves to question familiar voices.


Voice phishing, or “vishing,” bypasses email filters and technical safeguards by exploiting urgency, authority, and trust – targeting the human element directly.

Detecting audio deepfakes is difficult. Real-time detection tools are limited, and our ears are unreliable. Subtle clues may include robotic tones, odd pauses, unnatural breathing, or background noise that doesn’t quite fit – but they’re easy to miss under pressure.

As AI advances, voice scams will likely be joined by real-time video deepfakes, raising the stakes even higher. The question is no longer if this will impact businesses, but when.

Microsoft is testing a ‘resume from phone’ feature...

Windows 11 is testing a new “resume from phone” feature that lets you continue what you were doing on your Android device directly on your PC. If you open an online Word, Excel or PowerPoint file in the Microsoft 365 Copilot app on your phone, you can hand it off to your Windows PC with a single tap. Some phones can also pass browser tabs or Spotify sessions. It’s early days. Only a few Android brands support it, and it only works for online files, but it’s a promising step toward smoother crossdevice working on Windows.
